

QUALIFICATIONS AVAILABLE AT WHEELBASE**Motor Vehicle Qualifications**

These nationally recognised qualifications form the vocational, subject-based learning component of a Foundation Learning programme. There are no formal entry requirements and they are open to anyone aged 14 and over who is interested in learning about the maintenance of motor vehicles and the various career opportunities in the motor industry.

The qualifications are designed so that learners can achieve in small, manageable steps with assessments that suit practical and visual learners.

Functional Skills (English, Maths and ICT)

Functional Skills qualifications assess the essential skills, knowledge and understanding of English, Maths and ICT that will enable an individual to operate confidently and independently in life and work. The assessments are based on real life scenarios and can be paper based or online. Speaking and listening skills are assessed by a group discussion in the classroom and at Level 2 by a short presentation to the class group.

PSD (Personal and Social Development) units

Designed to help learners aged 14-19 years old to develop key personal skills, behaviours and attitudes that will prepare them to look for, obtain and maintain employment.

The Award is achieved using practical tasks, set in the motor vehicle environment, that allow learners to tackle new challenges individually and as part of a group.

OCR Life and Living Skills (Entry 2 and Entry 3)

A selection of bite-sized Entry level units that provide the opportunity for learners to develop the skills and underpinning knowledge to progress to a higher level, they form high quality, nationally recognised qualifications that earn credits as part of a Foundation Learning programme.

Any combination of a wide range of units at Entry Levels 2 and 3, including Communication, maths, personal skills and practical work skills, can be selected to build a personalised learning programme to suits the needs and interests of the learner.

From this year, young people who take part in our Out of Hours programme will also be able to achieve OCR Life and Living Skills qualifications.
