Level 2 Threshold = 5 GCSE A*-C (or equivalent) = 100%

Level 1 Threshold = 5 GCSE D-G (or equivalent) = 100%

Therefore one GCSE A*-C is equal to one fifth, or 20%, of the level 2 threshold
